- Rose Mary Tejada-Torres wants to know whether or not there will be a sixth grade orientation. President Lisa Johnson explained that all the orientations are on the calendar. Ms. Torres wanted to know when the calendars were being distributed.

- Michael Canestro said he wanted clarification about the Summer Academic Success Program. He wanted to know if the Summer Academic Success Programs were for students who were failing.
